1. The Military Literary Festival Association (MLFA), under the Chairmanship of Lieutenant General TS Shergill, PVSM (Retired), organizes the MLF in Chandigarh every year, generally in December. Presiding over the closing ceremony in the 6th edition of the MLF, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Punjab, Sh. Bhagwant Singh Mann desired the Festival to be conducted in other districts to reach out to the maximum youth to apprise them of our rich military, culture, and history by engaging the local academicians and experts of higher educational institutions. We successfully organized the first MLF (outside Chandigarh) at Patiala in January 23. The main objectives of the Festival are:-

(a) Organize panel discussions on contemporary strategic international and national affairs, engaging the experts, authors, writers, journalists, war correspondents, and research fellows of national, regional, and international reputation.

(b) To showcase the stories of courage, bravery, valor, sacrifice, and leadership of the Armed Forces in a challenging environment through a series of short movies titled 'Clarion Call.'

(c) To showcase the military equipment of the Indian Army and its characteristics to the public.

- (a) Panel Discussions. There will be 8 panel discussions. Proposed subjects are attached, as Appendix.
- (b) Display of exhibition of paintings, vintage weapons, stamps on military themes.
- (c) Clarion Call. To showcase films of valour & gallantry by various Regiments & units of the Army, Navy & Air force.
- (d) Book Reviews.
- (e) Philately exhibition
- (f) Food Court
- (g) Military Equipment Display including AD guns, Tanks, APCs, Arty guns and infantry weapons.
- (h) Stall ex-Army Recruiting Office to attract youth of the region to join armed forces.
- (j) Participation by Living PVC & MVC winners to the main festival who will motivate youth / college / university students during the event of SAMVAAD.
- (k) Organise Army Martial dances at Sukhna Lake, which have been a major attraction during past festivals. This includes GATKA team ex Punjab regt., Malkham, Khukhri Dance & Bhangra.

May I Request you to give wide publicity of the event to all Schools/Colleges/Universities under your jurisdiction so that there is maximum attendance of professors, teachers, students & research scholars. SUBJECTS FOR MLF PANEL DISCUSSIONS FOR 7TH MILITARY LITERATURE FESTIVAL CHANDIGARH ON 02-03 DEC-23 AT LAKE SPORTS COMPLEX, SUKHNA LAKE, CHANDIGARH

Based upon the theme "The World in Turmoil and Lessons of History," eight subjects for discussions have been chosen. The panels would comprise a moderator, an expert in the subject and one devil's advocate; each expert would have to send in a paper that will be published in an MLFA E Book and have 20-30 minutes to present his paper ensuring that at least 20-25% comprises audio visuals; the devil's advocate would have 10-15 minutes; there would be 15-30 minutes for audience participation.

The eight subjects are given below: -

1. China started its military modernisation in 1995; where is China today in terms of research, reverse engineering and self-reliance? How does India fare in this regard and for how long will India have to rely upon import of military weapons and technology and the strategic embrace of another nation? *"Victorious warriors win first and then go to war, while defeated warriors go to war first and then seek to win"*- Sun Tzu.
2. The conflict in Ukraine under a nuclear umbrella is perhaps, a trailer of what modern warfare and selective total war could be in South Asia. What should be the Diplomatic and Military Strategy for India that has operate in the high mountains, plains and in the oceans? *"He will win who knows when to fight and when not to fight"*- Sun Tzu.
3. Pakistan is still a feudal society with the military at its helm; it is currently at its lowest ebb economically and politically, with an orthodox ideology of the Taliban expectantly waiting in the wings to enter from the northwest. What are the scenarios that could arise from this combustive mix and the strategy India should follow? *"In the midst of chaos, there is also opportunity."*- Sun Tzu.
4. Alexander the Great and Ashoka the Great were separated by fifty years however their achievements were monumental although, their methods towards greatness were not the same. Is their legacy relevant today? *"The greatest victory is that which requires no battle."*- Sun Tzu.

5. Qin Shihuang the Great (秦始皇), actual name 嬴政 (Ying Zheng). Reigned 247 BC to 221 BC as King of Qin and reigned 221 BC to 210 BC as Emperor of China (the Qin Dynasty); through brutal methods and military conquest, he united the bickering states of Ancient China under one rule for the first time in its history and built the Great Wall. From Mao Zedong till today Chinese leaders believe in the success of his methods. How does this philosophy portend for Asia and the world? *"It is easy to love your friend, but sometimes the hardest lesson to learn is to love your enemy."* Sun Tzu.
6. Do big battalions win against insurgents/ anti national elements (ANEs)/ militants/ terrorists or, small units that are trained to be independent and sharp? *"Quickness is the essence of the war."* – Sun Tzu.
7. The Lahore Durbar and its gift of the North West Frontier, Kashmir, Baltistan and Ladakh to India. *"You have to believe in yourself."* – Sun Tzu.
8. Martial Poetry of Punjab. *"There are not more than five musical notes, yet the combinations of these five give rise to more melodies than can ever be heard."* – Sun Tzu
